



Summary of the CTSE's Main Regulations

Grades 1 to 12

CTSE002 – TRANSPORTATION ELIGIBILITY

Walking distances between the school and the residence and/or the address on file:

- Grades 1 to 3 → 0.8 km
- Grades 4 to 6 → 1.0 km
- Grades 7 to 12 → 2.0 km

Walking distance between the residence and/or the address on file can reach:

- Grades 1 to 12 → 500 m

CTSE012 – ESTABLISHMENT OF SCHOOL VEHICLE ROUTES

For students from Pre-Kindergarten to Grade 6, the route can last up to 60 minutes.
For students from Grades 7 to 12, the route can last a maximum of up to 90 minutes.

CTSE014 – LOCATION OF STOPS

Without exception, all students must walk to a corner stop or a common stop in order to take their school vehicle. Home stops are only authorized when the speed limit exceeds 50 km/h.



CTSE015 – COURTESY TRANSPORTATION

Beginning October 1st, courtesy transportation may be granted to students who are within the walking distance to school. Certain conditions apply. The form is available as of September 15th only.

CTSE016 – JOINT CUSTODY

Transportation to two addresses may be assigned in the case of joint custody. Both addresses must be in the school zone and a regular schedule must be provided to the CTSE.

The Joint Custody form, signed by both parents, must be submitted to the CTSE before the request can be evaluated.

CTSE004 – STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

The student must respect the school's code of conduct which applies at all times aboard the school vehicle.

The student must be at the designated stop ten (10) minutes before the school vehicle's scheduled arrival time.

The student must follow the driver's instructions and respect Bus Patrol representatives.

Pre-Kindergarten & Kindergarten

CTSE002 – TRANSPORTATION ELIGIBILITY

Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten students can walk up to 250m to their designated stop.

Students residing within 100m of the school are not eligible for school transportation.

CTSE012 – ESTABLISHMENT OF SCHOOL VEHICLE ROUTES

The route can last up to 60 minutes.

CTSE013 – DISEMBARKATION OF PRE-KINDERGARTEN AND KINDERGARTEN STUDENTS

In accordance with the IMJ program, all Pre-Kindergarten and Kindergarten students must be met by a designated responsible adult at their drop-off location.

CTSE014 – LOCATION OF STOPS

Without exception, all students must walk to a corner stop or a common stop in order to take their school vehicle. Home stops are only authorized when the speed limit exceeds 50 km/h.



CTSE016 – JOINT CUSTODY

Transportation to two addresses may be assigned in the case of joint custody. Both addresses must be in the school zone and a regular schedule must be provided to the CTSE.

The Joint Custody form, signed by both parents, must be submitted to the CTSE before the request can be evaluated.

CTSE004 – STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES
